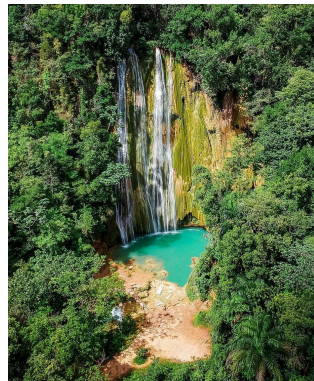

Santo Domingo

History and nightlife

Tag 01 | 04. March

Arrival in Santo Domingo in the evening and check-in at our 3★ hotel (Rig Colonial Experiences) where we will stay for the next 4 nights. We will have dinner together to start our journey.

Included: Transfer from the airport to the hotel, accomodation

Day 02 | 05. March

After a delicious breakfast at our hotel, we will start with the first dance lessons. In the afternoon, we will have a historical and cultural walk through the streets of the colonial city of Santo Domingo with our local guide. In the evening, let's put those skills and moves learned today into practice when we go out together.

Included: Accommodation with breakfast, dance lessons, guided city tour

Day 03 | 06. March

After breakfast, we will kick-off the day with more dance lessons to refine your steps. In the afternoon, our first special workshop will take place, about something authentic from the Dominican Republic (stay curious!). As the night falls, we will enjoy an open-air concert with local music and the nightlife of Santo Domingo.

Day 04 | 07. March

Included: Accommodation, dinner and social dancing with Ninafrika Dance School

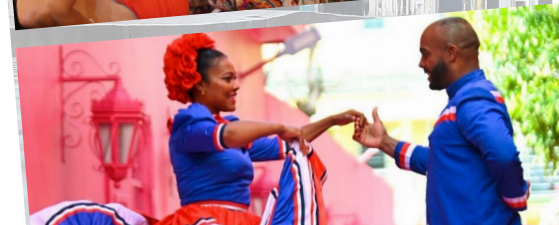
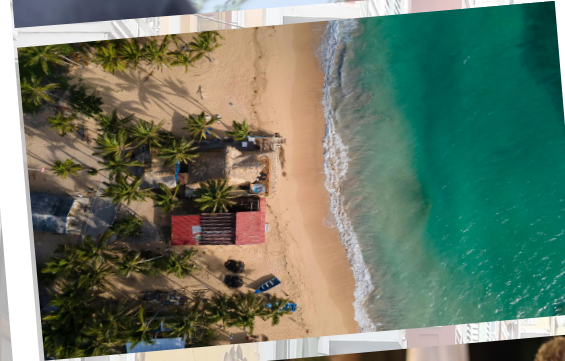
Day 10 | 13. March

How can I book and pay?

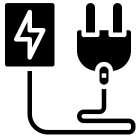
Good to know about the destination



Summer is the warmest season in the country, with maximum temperatures of 32°C. From April to October, humidity can be high due to some short-lasting rainfall.



Bring your swimsuit, long cotton clothes for sun protection and shorts for the beach, but also pack casual daywear for city visits. Bring prescription medications, your favorite sunscreen — limited brands are available here — a hat, sunglasses, and mosquito repellent.



Electricity in the Dominican Republic is powered by 110 volts. Travelers coming from Europe or other regions that are powered by 220 volts must bring adapters like those for the USA.



Tap water should not be drunk. Always buy bottled water or drink from the drinking water dispensers that can be found in most hotels.



The official language of the Dominican Republic is Spanish. If you don't speak Spanish, however, it's not a problem: English is widely spoken in the tourist areas.



The local currency is the Dominican peso (RD\$). The exchange rate fluctuates daily. Euros can be exchanged in banks or in authorized exchange offices throughout the country. ATMs are widely available. The Spanish word for ATM is “cajero”.



Restaurant invoices automatically include a 10% service charge — apart from the 18% sales tax, which is listed as ITBIS. However, it is common and recommended to leave an additional 10% to ensure that the waiter receives a tip.



For emergencies, including the ambulance, fire department, and police, dial 911.

Terms & Conditions

- It is the responsibility of each traveller to carry the required travel documents valid **(more than six months after the end of the trip)** and in good condition.
- Every traveller is obliged to behave respectfully and to respect the rights of the individual, the environment, the cultural and natural heritage of our countries, as well as the beliefs, customs and way of life of the inhabitants of the places he/she visits.
- Behaviors that affect the safety and well-being of other group members, such as drug use, are strictly prohibited.
- Check-in and check-out times are determined by each hotel. Rooms are usually available from 15:00.

ROUTES - The itineraries have been carefully planned. However, due to operational reasons, weather conditions, political factors or other contingencies, it may be necessary to change the order of activities in this route. These are exceptional cases and the traveller will be informed as soon as possible. In order to improve the traveler's experience, the order of the excursions can also be changed at short notice.

SERVICES NOT INCLUDED - Each traveler is responsible for administrative procedures such as: obtaining and updating passports, flights, drinks, laundry service, communication (phone calls, faxes, emails, etc.), gratuities or other services and fees not explicitly stated in the itinerary.

UNUSED SERVICES - Some services may be interrupted or cancelled due to weather conditions or other external events beyond our control. No refunds can be made due to such interruptions or cancellations that are beyond our control.
