



Santo Domingo

History and nightlife

Tag 01 | 03. September

Arrival in Santo Domingo in the evening and check-in at our 3★ hotel (Rig Colonial Experiences) where we will stay for the next 4 nights. We will have dinner together to start our journey.

Day 02 | 04. September



In the afternoon, we will have a historical and cultural walk through the streets of the colonial city of Santo Domingo with our local guide. In the evening, let's put those skills and moves learned today into practice when we go out together.

Day 03 | 05. September

After breakfast, we will kick-off the day with more dance lessons to refine your steps. In the afternoon, our first special workshop will take place with a lecture on the origins of bachata and a live demonstration. As the night falls, we will enjoy an open-air concert with local music and the nightlife of Santo Domingo.

Day 04 | 06. September

The first activity of the day is our dance lessons. In the afternoon, we will visit a place that focuses on cultural exchange with the Dominican locals – Los Carrandales. In the evening, we will celebrate our last night in this city with a lively bar-hopping adventure.

Day 05 | 07. September

Enjoy the morning at leisure (e.g. to relax, shop or explore), because after lunch we will leave the city and drive to the northeast coast of this beautiful island: Las Terrenas, Samana.

Day 05 | 07. September

Arrival in Las Terrenas and check-in at our $4 \pm$ hotel (Costarena Beach) will take place in the late afternoon, where we will stay the next 4 nights. We invite you to stroll through the streets and across the beaches and get acquainted with the small but vibrant community. In the evening we go out together and discover the local dance scene.

Day 06 | 08. September

Day 08 | 10. September


Today is at your leisure. Just lie on the beach or ask us about optional tours and/or activities you could do from here.

After breakfast, there will be dance lessons from the professional trainers of the Ninafrika Dance School. In the afternoon, you can walk along the wide coastline of this city to relax. Afterwards, we will go to the Tiki Bar to move to the pulse of Latin American music together with Ninafrica's local dance teachers.




Day 12 | 14. September

Good to know about the destination



Summer is the warmest season in the country, with maximum temperatures of <u>32°C</u>. From April to October, humidity can be high due to some short-lasting rainfall.



The official language of the Dominican Republic is <u>Spanish</u>. If you don't speak Spanish, however, it's not a problem: English is widely spoken in the tourist areas.



Bring your swimsuit, long cotton clothes for sun protection and shorts for the beach, but also pack casual daywear for city visits. Bring prescription medications, your favorite sunscreen — limited brands are available here — a hat, sunglasses, and mosquito repellent.



The local currency is the Dominican peso (RD\$). The <u>exchange rate</u> fluctuates daily. Euros can be exchanged in banks or in authorized exchange offices throughout the country. ATMs are widely available. The Spanish word for ATM is "cajero".



Electricity in the Dominican Republic is powered by 110 volts. Travelers coming from Europe or other regions that are powered by 220 volts must bring adapters like those for the USA.



Restaurant invoices automatically include a 10% service charge – apart from the 18% sales tax, which is listed as ITBIS. However, it is common and recommended to leave an additional 10% to ensure that the waiter receives a tip.



Tap water <u>should not be drunk</u>. Always buy bottled water or drink from the drinking water dispensers that can be found in most hotels.



For emergencies, including the ambulance, fire department, and police, dial <u>911</u>.

Terms & Conditions

- It is the responsibility of each traveller to carry the required travel documents valid (more than six months after the end of the trip) and in good condition.
- Every traveller is obliged to behave respectfully and to respect the rights of the individual, the environment, the cultural and natural heritage of our countries, as well as the beliefs, customs and way of life of the inhabitants of the places he/she visits.
- Behaviors that affect the safety and well-being of other group members, such as drug use, are strictly prohibited.
- Check-in and check-out times are determined by each hotel. Rooms are usually available from 15:00.

These are exceptional cases and the traveller will be informed as soon as possible. In order to improve the traveler's experience, the order of the excursions can also be changed at short notice.

UNUSED SERVICES - Some services may be interrupted or cancelled due to weather conditions or other external events beyond our control. No refunds can be made due to such interruptions or cancellations that are beyond our control.
